Requirements: Attaining this certification requires:

- Currently employed by or own a firm primarily engaged in remodeling and which operates in compliance with the NARI Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice
- Minimum of 16 hours of continuing education directly related to project management *or* attendance of NARI Certified Lead Carpenter online preparatory course
- Minimum of five (5) years continuous experience in the remodeling industry AND two (2) years in a lead carpenter role

Certified individuals must complete continuing education requirements on an annual basis to retain their certifications by attending industry-related seminars, workshops and classes each year to keep their knowledge current. Certified professionals must also adhere to NARI's Standards of Practice and Code of Ethics.
